Subject: Parking Garage Repairs

Effective **Monday, April 17:**

PARKING GARAGE REPAIRS

CVG's contractor will begin repair and maintenance work on the parking garage beginning Monday, April 17. Work is anticipated to last into early July. Disruption to customer parking will be minimized by using additional wayfinding signage and parking space availability indicators at the ticket entry points.

The work includes but not limited to:

- concrete repair
- crack scaling
- joint sealing
- membrane application

There may be a need for temporary lane closures for lift access work on the exterior of the overflow (Terminal 2) garage. Additional notifications will be sent as needed.

Effective **Saturday, April 22:**

ARRIVALS LEVEL LANE CLOSURE DURING OVERNIGHT HOURS

Weather permitting, CVG's contractor will be delivering materials for additional garage roof repairs. It will be necessary to close the outside lane of the Arrivals Level for crane use during the overnight hours. Work is tentatively scheduled to begin late Saturday due to the lowest level of flight arrival activity and to minimize disruptions. Work is will be between 11:30 p.m. (arrival and set-up) with the closure near midnight and completion before 8:00 am.

The work zone will be barricaded and traffic diverted to the inner curb lane as a temporary measure.

With the continued airport customer growth and ongoing construction efforts to improve our Airport Community, all personnel are reminded to exercise caution, be mindful of speed limits on and around CVG roads, and to utilize the designated pedestrian crosswalks and walk paths.
