- New numbering for parking assignments
- Modified service road to allow vehicles to remain clear of parked aircraft


Updated guidelines to illustrate the changes above, in addition to restrictions related to adjacent deice pads and no-taxi area, are included in the email distribution.


CVG Remote Parking as of October 28, 2014

- Remote Parking Pads are West of Terminal 1 and at Terminal 1 as depicted below in the green-hashed area
- Additional depictions based on aircraft type are on page 2
 - Yellow/Black dashed line Indicates Object Free Area (OFA); wingtips must remain clear, West of the line.
- Aircraft must remain clear of active taxl and roadways
- Daily fees apply
- Operator responsible for safety precautions and aircraft access (i.e. cones, FOD walks)
 - Operator must remove and stow any safety and access equipment when not in use (chocks, cones, stairs)
