ANTICIPATED INCREASE IN TRAFFIC AROUND DHL FACILITY

The recently announced Amazon Prime Air activity is scheduled to start Monday, May 1. The activity will operate from the DHL facility. Our Airport Community can anticipate an overall increase in vehicle and truck traffic associated with supporting this growth opportunity. The most critical congestion timing is estimated to be between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. during DHL shift transition, trucks heading to the sort facility or staging, and other company staff located around the South Service Area who are headed to their work sites.

All personnel are reminded to pay strict attention to speed limits, pavement conditions during inclement weather, and other potential hazards. The illustration below highlights the following key areas:

- Caution is urged at all times, especially at those locations circled in red
- Additional speed indicators and safety signage will be present along South Airfield Drive
- Those tenants in this area requiring **hazardous cargo [HC]** deliveries (see route) *may want to adjust their delivery schedules* to avoid the peak 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. window
- Estimating an addition of approximately 30-40 semi-tractor trailers



- DHL has developed a staging area on the south side of the East Service road to alleviate any potential congestion along Wendel Ford Blvd; trucks will follow the route indicated to this location where they will be dispatched back to the DHL docks on Wendel Ford Blvd
- Potential exists for additional truck congestion on Wendel Ford Blvd, headed North, as trucks position to unload/load
