Subject: Lightning Advisory Update

LIGHTNING ADVISORY UPDATE

Starting this Spring, the AOC will be adjusting our airport geographic center that is utilized to activate lightning alerts, including the strobes located on various structures around the property. This change is being made to better align with the population center of the airport. As you can see from the following diagrams, it has a minor effect on the 5-mile lightning ring, shifting it slightly to the southeast. The yellow circle and pin indicate the current center, while the red circle and pin indicate the new center.

As a reminder, lightning advisories are put into effect when cloud to cloud or cloud to ground lightning is occurring within the 5-mile ring and then is cancelled when lightning has not occurred in a 15-minute period. Note that KCAB lightning policies are applicable to KCAB personnel and contractors as well as fueling activity. Outside of these previously mentioned groups, ceasing operations due to lightning is at the discretion of individual tenants.
