Subject: CVG FAA Air Traffic Control Planned Outage
Date: May 31, 2018

Effective June 16th and June 30th

FAA Air Traffic Control (ATC) Planned Outage

The local CVG FAA ATC has informed the Airport that they are replacing their power control system (PCS) for their facilities. This will require a power outage to perform this work. This planned temporary power disruption will affect CVG Airport's FAA ATC facilities (Tower & TRACON). These facilities cannot be occupied during this time due to the lack of building power (lighting, life safety systems, etc.).

The date / time for this work will be conducted in two phases;

Phase	Start Date	Start Time	End Date	End Time
Phase 1	June 16, 2018	10:00 PM (EDT)	June 17, 2018	5:00 AM (EDT)
Phase 2	June 30, 2018	10:00 PM (EDT)	July 1, 2018	5:00 AM (EDT)

During this time, the CVG Airport will have the following conditions:

- VFR airport for the duration of the planned outage
- All air traffic will be handled by Indianapolis (ZID) Air Route Traffic Control Center
- ZID will sequence arrivals/departures
- Ground communications with Indianapolis ARTCC will be via telephone at (317) 247-2242
- Pilots and/or taxiing mechanics will be required to monitor 122.95 (UNICOM) as a Common Traffic Advisory Frequency (CTAF)
- No runway crossings during this time
- Weather will not be available
- Class B services are not available
