Subject: Lightning Strobe Relocation

Date: January 6, 2016

The lightning strobes that are used to visually notify personnel of cloud to ground lightning within 5 miles of the airport have moved. The visual strobe system is still in place on both Concourse A and Concourse B ramp towers but has been removed from the Concourse C ramp tower. These strobes have been relocated to the new KCAB Sign Shop building. This building as shown below on the map is adjacent to airfield entry gates NE-3 and NE-4 near the escort shack.

All airlines and tenants should remain familiar with the established severe weather procedures and take preventative steps to protect themselves from lightning strikes.
