

CVG Airport Authority Customer Experience & Airline Carriers Meeting Minutes June 6th, 2024

Call to Order and Introductory Remarks

The regular [in person] Customer Experience & Airline Carriers Meeting was called to order on <u>Thursday, June 6th, 2024, at 3:04 p.m. by Hans Stokke, CVGAA</u>.

Hans Stokke, CVGAA, reviewed all open items from the action item list, via verbal relay. Hans also provided group reminders, including the scope and purpose of this meeting.

New Business [As stated below]

Terminal Operations and Construction Related Activity

CVGAA -Hans Stokke provided the following updates and reminders:

- The second phase of the Passenger Boarding Bridge Project is still in progress, resulting in the closure of Gates B12 & B27. B6 is scheduled to be back online June 21st, subject to be completed ahead or behind schedule.
- The third phase of the Passenger Boarding Bridge Project is scheduled to begin on Monday, July 7th, after the three-week break period occurring from June 22nd to July 7th. This phase will immediately first impact Gates B1 & B2. *An operations memorandum will soon be distributed.*
- Hans provided notified the attendees that the next upcoming Customer Experience & Airline Carriers meeting will no occur on its typical cadence in July [normally occurs on the first Thursday of each month], but is rescheduled to occur on Wednesday, July 10th due to anticipated impacts of holiday traffic.
- Hans informed the group of recent csinfo document refinements; The Remote Overnight Parking [RON] Report has now been updated through August 2024 and will continue to be updated weekly. Please note that this document is subject to change without notice. *See the mentioned report attached below.*
- Hans provided a firm reminder regarding the appropriate smoking and break areas, as there has been an increase in misuse of the Concourse A Sensory Room (near Gate A4) and the Loading Dock at the Main Terminal. He urged the airline and tenant managers to remind their team members of where the appropriate smoking locations and break space are located.
 - As a result of ongoing employee misuse of the Concourse A Sensory room, the short wall partition will be removed for increased visibility, serving as a deterrent. No timeline was provided for this project.
 - Steve Listerman added that in Concourse B, there is another frequent smoking location located near Gate B15; attendees were reminded that the general location is not a designated smoking area and doing so will result in ramp citations.

Security Updates

CVGAA -Steve Listerman & Hans Stokke provided the following updates and reminders:

- Steve summarized that the previously mentioned Employee Screening Matrix door [207-8] configuration changeover has been completed and the appropriate signage has been placed. He reminded the group that the first door entering the secure screening area is a PIN & SWIPE, there is no piggybacking allowed. If an employee passes through without doing so, it can result in a one-week suspension of badge privileges.
 - Please refer to the May meeting minutes for more information.



Facilities & Maintenance

CVGAA – Tim Dodson & Hans provided the following information regarding recent outages:

- Hans invited a discussion about a recent Level 4 Baggage Outage that occurred on Sunday June 2nd. As a result, airline debriefs will be scheduled with airline carriers after each Level 4 Outage occurrence. Hans then reviewed the traditional expectations of baggage hygiene below:
 - Keep tags visible, wheels always up.
 - Spacing bags at least 12" apart.
 - Oversized bags and items outside of the following dimensions should always be taken to T-Drive for induction; 70" Long x 39" Wide X 36" High; 100+ Pounds.
- Hans informed attendees that no long-term parking is allowed on the yellow hashed lines in T-Drive. Parking the tugs for bag movement is allowed, but not for overnight/abandoned parking as it limits access to the carousels.
- Hans urged airlines to remember to shut off the FIS escalators once an international operation has ended. If more keys are needed to make this possible, please contact Larry Northcutt with the Lock Shop at LockShop@cvgairport.com., Turning off the escalators will increase the longevity of the equipment's life.
- Lastly, airlines now have access to a newly updated work request system. This will be made available via QR Code & Link with *Survey 123*. For reference the QR Code and link has been attached below.
- The final reminder provided was the appropriate behavior that is expected at BMUs, safety should always be prioritized near belts and equipment. Employees must always follow the appropriate protocol and procedure to prevent employee injury.

Safety Department Updates

CVGAA -Casey Kinosz provided the following updates and reminders:

- Casey Reviewed recent Near Misses that have occurred throughout the airfield. It is encouraged that employees always remain diligent and aware to prevent incidents from occurring. There have been about four near misses in 2024 alone, when an airport would usually see one of these described events occur a year. Casey offered to provide any materials or documents when talking with their ramp agents.
 - Steve Listerman added that incidents like this could be prevented when employees acknowledge and come to a full stop and the designated stop lines and look both ways before proceeding to cross areas.

CVGAA -Hans Stokke provided training opportunities for the following:

- Concourse A Wheelchair Installations have been completed and would like to request participation in training to prevent unnecessary damage. This training has been set to occur on June 10th, at 1200, at Gate A11.
 - Hans noted that this wheelchair lift is different than the lifts in Concourse B. When the [newly installed] Concourse A wheelchair lifts are in use, the auto level cannot operate simultaneously. The bridge must be stationary and be returned to its original up position upon completion of use.

Airfield Maintenance

CVGAA -Hans Stokke provided the following updates and reminders:

- Both Concourse A & B continue to collect pallets & skids in the improper areas, Hans provided a reminder of the appropriate pallet collection points per the recently distributed operations memorandum, attached.
- Hans posted the upcoming dates of the next FOD walks for both Concourses A and B; attendance is highly encouraged.
 - Concourse A: 06/19/2024
 - Concourse B: 06/26/2024

CVGAA – Hans updated current ongoing wildlife mitigation strategies:

• Hans summarized Bird nesting throughout Concourse B; Josh is currently looking at solutions and safeguards to mitigate this issue. The airlines will be updated with any changes/projects to occur.



IT Department Updates

CVGAA -Hans Stokke provided the following updates and reminders:

- Recently, an increase in work requests has occurred to bring common use stations back online. To prevent any operational issues, please do not unplug or unseat cables. Equipment is not to be relocated to another gate.
 - If more equipment is needed or any technological assistance is required, please contact IT Operations at 859-767-4565.

Airline and Stakeholder Updates

Alaska Airlines – Lexy House debriefed on recent issues:

• Lexi reported recent nesting cleanliness issues at Gate A7 Jet Bridge, the team has been performing nightly cleanups. A work order has been created to fix this issue.

Envoy - inquired about an upcoming change:

• The employee parking exit gate now has signage, notifying employees that a badge swipe will now be required to exit the lot, change effective the 17th. Hans will verify with concessions and confirm this change with the group.

British Airways - Lorraine Ellis offered the ongoing issues:

- Lorraine referred to the ongoing complications of overflowing trash bins. Steve Listerman and Casey Kinosz covered the ongoing locations of FOD buckets and removal/daily cadence of emptying of trash bins.
- Tim Dodson additionally alluded to the next Cleanup Day to be scheduled soon with more information to come.

Prospect - Derek updated the airline managers on current and upcoming staffing:

- There has been an overall staffing increase of 40%, supplemented by a higher attrition rate for all employees, general and supervisory. For comfortable growth and operation, there is a 200-person headcount goal.
- Supervisory staffing will now increase from 4 to 9 positions to increase our presence.
- All Prospect employees will now be required to have the Customs Hologram Seal and access to double doors. It is no longer a post onboarding task; it must be completed before starting.
- Prospect is going to bridge any communication gaps with Bags Inc., when transporting customers to the rental car facilities at CONRAC to eliminate unnecessary additional service times.
- 25 more Staxis have been ordered.

Effective March 27th, 2024

In the ongoing effort to strengthen the FOD program at the Airport, the current pallet (skid) disposal process is being revised to enhance efficiency and safety across our operations.

- Damaged pallets have been identified as a contributing factor to the debris found on the ramp.
- Improperly stored pallets may create safety hazards; blocking paths of egress, creating trip hazards, and/or presenting a fire hazard when collected in areas not designed for storage.

The pallet collection area located behind the triturator/wash rack will no longer be serviced. Two new collection points for wooden pallets will be activated and available for use by all Airlines and Tenants. Airport maintenance personnel will remove the pallets on a weekly basis, typically Saturday.



Concourse A - Pallet Collection Point

Gate A4 ramp area Near trash compactor Do not block path to/from dumpster



<u>Concourse B - Pallet Collection Point</u> Gate B13 ramp area North side of wall near trash compactor

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Only wood pallets should be placed in these areas. All Airlines and Tenants are responsible for their own disposal [or return to vendor] of plastic pallets.
- Discarded pallets shall not be stored in any other locations around concourses A and B.
- Pallets shall be stored in an orderly manner, in stacks of no more than 10 pallets.

Common Use Common Issues

No Simultaneous Logins This can cause issues like printing to multiple or incorrect positions. Airline applications not launching or malfunctioning. Or other unforeseen issues.

The number one issue we see with common use hardware is peripherals that are not connected. You may find a printer that won't print or a scanner that won't scan. If the screen on them says link down, as shown below (a), you will need to restart the machine. After a restart you will come to the common use login screen (b).

When you come to this page after a restart, please do not log in for three to five minutes. There are critical background services that need time to start and connect to all peripherals. Typically, after they have started the peripherals will show online. (There are times before that three-to-five-minute

window where it will show online (c) but will then go back to link down before coming back online.) Log in as normal after this window.

When an issue arises that is not resolved by a restart, please reach out to the CVG Helpdesk.

NEVER unplug any cables from any computer or peripheral unless instructed by IT.

NEVER plug anything into the computer or any peripherals. This includes phone chargers, and USB drives.
