Subject: FAA Ban on Samsung Galaxy Note 7

**Date:** October 15, 2016

The FAA has issued "CertAlert" to all Title 14 Part 139 Airport Operators, which includes CVG. CertAlert No. 16-08 asks "airport operators to use all possible means to notify all their passengers of the ban" directed at the Samsung Galaxy Note 7 smartphone. As such, airport Flight Information Display Systems (FIDS) banks that are controlled by CVG will display applicable messaging. Additionally, popup banners will be used to communicate the same prior to entering security.
