Subject:	CVG Designated as Entertainment Destination Center

EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 22nd

CVG has obtained an Entertainment Destination Center (EDC) license from the Kentucky Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. The EDC license will allow passengers to carry open containers of alcohol throughout the concourses and tunnel. These beverages can only be purchased from restaurants/bars listed below. No outside alcohol can be brought in for consumption.

Participating restaurants/bars:

<u>Concourse A</u> Cork N Bottle The Local

Christian Moerlein Stella/Urban Market

> Concourse B Outback Cork N Bottle Hop and Cask

Alcohol "to go" from restaurants/bars will be put into clear plastic cups that have the name of the restaurant/bar on them. Therefore, there should be NO beer bottles, cans or glassware of any kind outside of the restaurants/bars. *Additionally, none of these beverages in plastic cups can be taken through the security exit or onto aircraft.*

Rules for the CVG EDC are as follows:

- CVG EDC days/hours: 24 hours per day & 7 days per week
- Open alcoholic beverages may be carried, possessed, and consumed within the public areas of Concourses A & B, the connecting transportation tunnel and into participating airport concessions (stores & restaurants).
- Alcohol must be purchased from a licensed alcohol concession within the CVG EDC.
- Open alcohol may only be carried in a CVG EDC approved cup.
- Open alcohol may be carried into participating airport concessions (stores & restaurants), unless prohibited by a business.
- No alcohol from outside sources may be consumed in the CVG EDC.
- Open alcohol may not be taken outside the CVG EDC for any reason (not onto aircraft or through security exit).

- All state and local laws are strictly enforced in the CVG EDC, including public intoxication and disorderly conduct.
- All alcohol concessions shall refuse to sell or provide a CVG EDC approved cup to any person or persons who are visually intoxicated.
- All discarded cups must be disposed of properly in waste or recycling containers.
